

Effective Action

The project began in August 2012 to address the basic nutritional needs of the community in the populations of focus in the government's Poverty Eradication programs. Specifically, these are orphans and vulnerable children, and elderly with ailing health.

We take an integrated, sustainable, and people driven approach to empower individuals through proper nutrition.

Empower

The Economic Empowerment Project was started in 2017 to teach parents skills to make various products. The goal is to create an income source so they may feed their children once they are no longer eligible for Nutrimeal.

- Beaded bracelets to raise awareness of malnutrition

Nutrimeal

Nutrimeal is a fully fortified porridge that provides sufficient daily vitamins and minerals. It is cost effective, does not require cooking, and easily prepared by mixing with water,

- Distributed 5 days a week at kgotlas in Maun to children under 6 years
- Mix given to make weekend servings at home
- Elderly over 65 years receive a weekly supply of mix
